




The Project



The Executive Committee of HUMANE decided to develop a new network activity, especially of interest for the younger, ambitious members of the university administration: a staff training program to support early career development.



Objective



To develop and implement a new HUMANE activity aiming at professionals in the university administration in an early career position: a training for the professionals with potential to grow in their careers and make promotion into management positions.

Trainees will learn to:

- Understand different university models for administration and organization
- Analyse and understand various funding arrangements, including understanding of European R&Dfunding
- Learn about strategic planning and institutional change
- Develop a critical approach towards organizational development and innovation, understanding the relevance of (national) context, scalability and transferability of best practice.



The Format



- 3 modules per year (1 week each).
- Each module is the same, but each of them will be organized with and within a different university.
- The trainees will visit universities in other European countries, meet colleagues from other universities in Europe, and learn from the experience at other universities.





The Topic




The invited universities should identify their strategic excellence areas and confirm their availability for hosting meetings and/or staff training.

Excellence areas can be for example:

- Strategic planning and organizational development;
- University administration and the organization of support units;
- Career development and leadership (training);
- Innovations in education;
- Student mobility and student marketing
- Internationalization;
- Resources management and funding.



Fee/cost



The fee will be as low as possible.

Additional sources of funding (EU - ERASMUS) will be approached to seek a budget for the project development.







Registration and Fee


The number of participants is strictly limited to 18. To participate you are kindly requested to fill in the form available at the HUMANE web site www.humane.eu.
