## Measuring the University's Performance: Data for Decisions

Making decisions is at the heart of our profession. Making the right and well-informed decisions is a challenge. Good decisions are not only founded in experience and intuition, but to a very large extent on facts and data.

Facts and data are very often clear and straightforward, but in many cases also ambiguous and difficult to collect.

Discussions about definitions and sources and about interpretation and reliability cloud the decision making process.

Relying upon data and facts in university management seems very obvious, but it seems that opinions and differences in interpretation very often lead to "political" discussions.

The question is how we can use management information in a way that helps university management and how we can evaluate our decisions.

One of the issues raised will be the question how we can use data and information of a less straightforward or obvious nature. Can we always measure and report what we want to know?

Can we use and trust data from other sources than the university administration? Can we use the expertise within the university?

This Conference will discuss how to support the decision making processes at the universities, how to obtain, process and save data and how to use data better for decision making.
